Message Title: When Jesus Changes Things!

Passage: John 2:1-11

Main Point: What can Jesus do when our “is what it is”, is

3. Think of a time where your “is what it is”, was not what
it should be. How did Jesus change you when you invited
Him into that situation?
4. Pick a person, other than Jesus, from the story that John
records in today's passage. Place yourself in the story and
share what you might have thought, felt, and done.
5. Share a time that Jesus changed something that you had
no power to change. How did He do abundantly more than
you expected?
6. Bonus: Read John 1:1-18 again. Of the five angles of
looking at Jesus we find there (God, creation, witness,
world, family) which do you see repeated in this week's
passage? How does John deepen them?
