# **Sermon Based Small Group Questions**

Message Title:	God's Expectations for Each of Us
Passage:	Ephesians 4:7-16
Main Point:	God has given <u>EACH OF US</u> a <u>GIFT</u> that He <u>EXPECTS</u> us to <u>INVEST</u> in <u>ALL OF US</u>

- 1 Why do you think it is so difficult for us to believe that a single life can have much of an impact on the big picture of things? What type of people do we often assume that "big impact" lives are reserved for? Is that the Biblical pattern?
- 2 Each of us is born with natural talents and abilities. We can also learn skills. Spiritual gifts are given to us by the Holy Spirit when we come to Christ. What are some ways each of us might discover our Spiritual gifts?
- 3 In addition to the Spiritual gifts that each of us have been given, some of us have been fitted by God to be equippers for the church. Why do you think Paul views these folks as "gifts" to the church?
- 4 Paul listed four of these equipper gifts: apostles (developers), prophets (forth-tellers), evangelists (gospel facilitators), and pastor / teachers (shepherds and mediators of the Word). Think of examples from your own experience of each and what their ministry looked like as well as their impact on you. How would we know if God has selected us for one of these leading / equipping roles?
- 5 The ultimate goal for each of us functioning properly (investing our gifts) in the church is for all of us to grow to be more and more like Jesus and to be unified in the faith. What might get in the way of that? How does Satan try to create disunity around the gifts?
- 6 What are some things that should motivate us to discover and use the "just right" gifting God has given to each of us? Take a look at the Spiritual gifts described in Romans 12:6-8, 1 Corinthians 12:4-11, and 1 Corinthians 12:28. Talk about what your are and how you are using them. Also share what you have observed as gifts in other in the group.
