Message Title:	Nunc Dimittis
Passage:	Luke 2:21-40.

- Main Point: Christmas gives us the perfect gift, the only gift worth singing about.
 - 1. Read Luke 2:21-40 as a group. What stands out to you?

- 3. According to Luke, our deepest need is our alienation from God and from others. Which type of alienation is your greatest need right now? Why?
- 4. Both Simeon and Anna had to wait decades for their perfect gift to arrive. It cost them a life-time of waiting. What is the hardest thing about waiting? How can God use waiting in our lives? What can we do to wait well?
- 5. The gift cost to Mary unimaginable pain. Can you think of a time when God used pain in your life for good?
