Sermon Based Small Group Questions

Message Title: Productive Life

Passage: John 15:1-17

Main Point: We live productive lives when we produce

what is expected by the One who created

us.

- Read John 15:1-17 as a group. What stands out to you?
 What questions does it raise? How does it challenge you?
- 2. Think of a time that you either made something, planted something, or purchased something that didn't produce as expected. What was that experience like?
- 3. Read Isaiah 5:1-7 together as a group. How does this background help us to understand Jesus' allegory of the vineyard better?
- 4. What are some things you might do on a regular basis to make sure to are staying connected to Jesus?
- 5. During the sermon, we were asked to reflect on the question, "Will you be pruned or thrown away?" What was your initial reaction to that question? Why?
- 6. John highlights some of the fruit that God expects our lives to bear: powerful prayer, Jesus' joy, love for God and for others, and a life that makes God more visible to the world. Which of these is your greatest need right now? Pray for each other as a group.
- 7. If tomorrow you knew that everything about this passage except one thing would be forever erased from your memory, what would you want that one thing you retain to be? Why?
